STATED GENERAL MEETING – SATURDAY, 12 JUNE 2021

RECORD OF DECISIONS

1. APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEES

The College approved various changes in committee memberships.

2. ELECTIONS TO FELLOWSHIPS

The College formally agreed:

- (i) That, with effect from 7 November 2021, Alexander GEORGIU be elected to a Fellowship under Statute III, cl. 2(iii) (Research) until the expiry of his Examination Fellowship in 2026. He will complete his DPhil and spend the remainder of his fellowship turning it into a monograph. The details of this project are set out in his letter of application.
- (ii) That, with effect from 7 November 2021, Lucas TSE be elected to a Fellowship under Statute III, cl. 2(iii) (Research) until the expiry of his Examination Fellowship in 2026. He will complete his DPhil and spend the remainder of his fellowship turning it into a monograph. The details of this project are set out in his letter of application.
- (iii) That Philipp NOFHAF and Erik PANZER be elected to Fellowships under Statute III, cl. 10 (Fellowships tenable by ex-Fellows) for a period of seven years with effect from 13 June 2021. The Notice was circulated in accordance with the decision of the Stated General Meeting on 13 March 2021.
- (iv) That Paul SEABRIGHT be elected to a Fellowship under Statute III, cl. 8 (Fellowship tenable by any person who has been a Fellow or a Visiting Fellow and is able to advance the purposes of the College) for two years with effect from 1 October 2021. He will give a series of sixteen seminars on 'How religions compete: a long-term economic perspective'.
- (v) That Simon GREEN and Tom SEAMAN be elected to Fellowships under Statute III, cl. 14 (Emeritus Fellowship) at the end of their current Fellowships. The Notice was circulated in accordance with the recommendation of the General Purposes Committee.
